



## UNIFIED CARRIER REGISTRATION

UCR is the Unified Carrier Registration program created by federal legislation, it replaces the former system for registering the operators of vehicles engaged in interstate travel – the Single State Registration System (SSRS).

The federal UCR Agreement requires individuals and companies that operate commercial motor vehicles in interstate or international commerce to register their business with a participating state and pay an annual fee (generally before January 1st) based on the size of their fleet. This includes ALL carriers - private, exempt, or for hire, brokers, freight forwarders and leasing companies are also required to register and pay a fee unless they also operate as a motor carrier.

If you cross into a UCR participating state without having paid your UCR fee, the state and its USDOT officers will pull your trucks off the road immediately. They will not release your trucks until your UCR fees are paid.
